I am writing to tell you about an important change to the information in the consultation booklets that were sent to you recently.

The booklet says that the earliest any change could happen to schools if options went ahead would be September 2011.

In theory, this is still possible. But because the timescale has changed since the booklet was printed, we will recommend to Council's Cabinet that any school changes don't happen until September 2012. Remember, this is only if Cabinet decides that an option should go ahead.

September 2012 means that whether there are changes to schools or not, all children now in Year 6 and in Year 5 can carry on going to their current primary school until they leave for secondary school.

I do understand that change can be worrying. It is important to keep in mind that a decision has not been made. The consultation continues until 3rd December. Please use this chance to have your views heard and taken into account.
